The Chairman invited the governing council members and look them around the campus and visited the lecturer Block (Beta Block), Workshop building (Delta block) Library (Omega block), Boys and Girls Hostels and Cafeteria. Chairman also explained that the need for the AC class rooms and AC buses and decision of the management to provide these facilities to the students on par with Foreign University standards. Chairman explained that the trust is strongly against getting any capitation fee from any students including foreign students.

During the visit to the Workshop (Beta block), Chairman explained that he has fulfilled the desire to purchase of all the important machines required for the future development of Mechanical Engineering lab, CSE, & Electronics& Communication Engineering. The meeting began with the welcome address by the chairman, informing the members about the fall of students admitted to the B.E degree course in spite an overall decrease in the Engineering colleges. He explained to reduce the intake in Mechanical & civil engineering from 240 to 120 & 120 to 60 respectively.

The chairman informed the members about the proposal of conduct another job-fair on 20th and 21st march 2020 for thousands of students of all engineering colleges in which at least 30 companies will be participating. The members have appreciated the idea.

The chairman stated that the cafeteria which is run by the management is providing quality service to the students and staff. Keeping in mind the increased strength in the college the management has allowed the running of additional facility like zeroing and kiosks by outside parties for providing food items.

The council members appreciated the construction of additional class room facilities (New block-zeta Block) within a short period and informed to construct few more this yaer.

Chairman requested the members to express their suggestion about the start of research labs in a phased manner & to start new institution. Members welcomed the move in the future but expressed their opinion that one of the conditions for getting the recognition from the university is that the college should have been started at least 5 years before. During the meeting the chairman the chairman insisted the requirement of conductive atmosphere in the campus to have a green campus with trees and pleasing shrubs and flowing plants, good playground, AC class rooms which will enable the students to study in peace.

The Chairman explained the difficulty in running the Institution (PERIIT) with poor intake's in Engineering steams, and hence decided to allocate minimum required land as per AICTE norms for Engineering college. Therefore out ot15.6 acres ,7.5 acres will be allocated for the existing PERI Institute of Technology. Moreover excess land will be allocated in future for Arts & Science or Pharmacy college & other college in later stages. Principal informed the members about the NOC received from AICTE to set up & other educational institutions in the campus.



The committee emphasized in the last meeting about the need for the improvement of training facilities to the students to improve their communication skills to meet the challenges of other competitors. Chairman has announced that he has arranged the necessary training facilities for all the students through PERI Software and PERI IT.

Minutes of Meeting

The Chairman invited the governing council members and look them around the campus and visited the lecturer Block (Beta Block), Workshop building (Delta block) Library (Omega block), Boys and Girls Hostels and Cafeteria. Chairman also explained that the need for the AC class rooms and AC buses and decision of the management to provide these facilities to the students on par with Foreign University standards. Chairman explained that the trust is strongly against getting any capitation fee from any students including foreign students.

During the visit to the Workshop (Beta block), Chairman explained that he has fulfilled the desire of Prof Dr. C. Chenniraj to purchase of all the important machines required for the future development of Mechanical Engineering lab, Electronics& Communication Engineering. Chairman showed the smart class rooms built in the third floor of the delta block.

The meeting began with the welcome address of the chairman, informing the members about the increased number of students admitted to the B.E degree course in spite an overall decrease in the applications of Engineering colleges.

Chairman informed the members that all ordered equipments have started arriving and the process will be completed within short time. Chairman also informed about the increase in the number of AC buses from 18 to 21 and the decision to purchase more AC buses in the academic year. Chairman informed the members that the Boy's hostel (ground plus 3 floors) and Girls hostel buildings (ground floor) are most completed. Chairman informed the members about the completion of additional lecture halls (Zeta block) within a short period.

The chairman informed the members about the proposal of conduct another job-fair on 20th and 21st march 2018 for thousands of students of all engineering colleges in which 40 companies will be participating. The members have appreciated the idea.

The chairman stated that the cafeteria which is run by the management is providing quality service to the students and staff. Keeping in mind the increased strength in the college the management has allowed the running of additional facility like zeroing and kiosks by outside parties for providing food items.

The council members appreciated the construction of additional class room facilities (New block-zeta Block) within a short period.



Chairman requested the members to express their suggestion about the start of research labs in a phased manner. Members welcomed the move in the future but expressed their opinion that one of the conditions for getting the recognition from the university is that the college should have been started at least 7 years before. During the meeting the chairman the chairman insisted the requirement of conductive atmosphere in the campus to have a green campus with trees and pleasing shrubs and flowing plants, good playground, AC class rooms which will enable the students to study in peace.
